Children Just Like Me™ is a 2,500 square-foot multi-cultural exhibit offering visitors the chance to become acquainted with children from around the world.

An introductory computer interactive encourages young visitors to discover the languages of all eleven children in the exhibit, while making relational geographic comparisons on the oversized globe.



Vignettes take visitors around the world to meet their peers from eleven countries on six continents.



Visit Celina in her home in the Amazon rain forest. Identify the sounds of the rain forest in this interactive game.



Bogna lives in Poland. She loves to make masks and puppets. Look at the ones Bogna has made for you. Be creative and make one of your own.



Bogna lives with her family on a farm in central Europe. Listen to the animal sounds she hears around the farm and learn their names in Polish.



Esta belongs to the Maasai people of East Africa. She wears colorful necklaces made from hundreds of beads. Try making some patterns with these snap-together beads.





Erdene is from Mongolia and lives in a circular tent called a ger. Pet his horse and braid a rope made of horse hair that is used to help hold the ger together.



Sarala lives in a village at the southern tip of India. Can you guess what kind of animal her pet is by the sound he makes?



Olia is eight years old and lives in Russia. She is training to be a professional ballerina. Try on her ballet slippers and tutu. Look in the mirror to see if you can stand on your toes or place your feet in one of the ballet positions.

Levi is eight years old and lives in Canada. He loves to play with his toy cars. Push his toy cars around the track in his bedroom.
