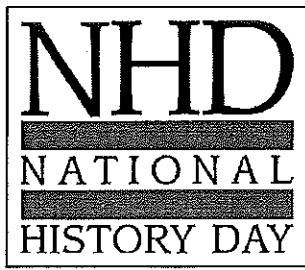

Try to remove "absolutes" from the dialogue. Ex: "All women were housewives or forced to quit their jobs." A more accurate sentence would be "Many women felt pressure to stay at home."
