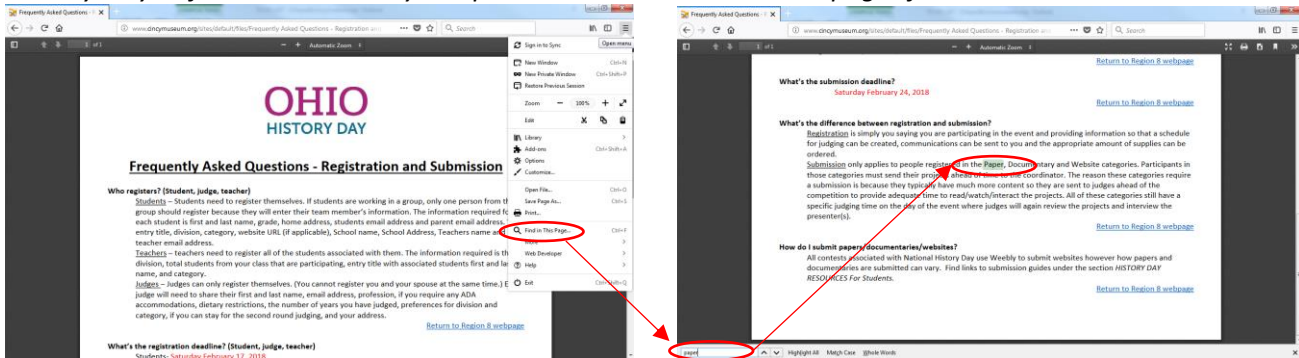

Where is the event?

What is the accessibility of this location?

While the campus has major elevation changes, TUC is accessible from every parking facility on campus. Within the building are several elevators and stair cases. The public spaces are very open and easy to maneuver. Some of the classrooms are smaller and may be filled with chairs and/or tables making it more difficult to move around.
