Chaperone Information & Schedule

Before you begin your visit, please read and communicate the following behavior expectations with your students.

Stay Safe – Always walk and use an inside voice. Enjoy equipment in a safe way. Respect posted age limits, capacity limits, guardrails or barriers in certain exhibits. All chaperones must wear wristbands that list prearranged experiences. Ask your students to look for a museum staff person if they get separated from the group or need assistance.

Stay Together – Students and chaperones must stay in their assigned group for the entire visit and follow their planned schedule. Students must always remain with their assigned chaperone. Children wishing to shop at the museum gift shop need to be escorted by a chaperone.

Clean Up – Keep food and drink (including gum) only in the permitted areas. Food and drink is prohibited in all exhibits, including the OMNIMAX Theater. Place trash in the proper trash/recycling bins. Smoking is not permitted on Cincinnati Museum Center property.

Show Respect – Be respectful to staff, other guests, exhibits, each other and ourselves. Also, have fun!

Groups who do not follow the behavior expectations may be asked to leave Cincinnati Museum Center and could have visiting privileges suspended.
