# Food, Beverage and Additional Accessibility Amenities

### Allergies

- CMC is NOT a nut free facility because guests are allowed to bring their own food.
- However, all four of CMC's onsite dining options are peanut free and have nutritional & allergy information on hand.





## **Ordering & Seating**

- All seating can be manipulated as needed.
- Our free-standing kiosk to self order in the Losantiville Cafe is at a wheelchair-compatible height.







#### **Wheelchairs & Strollers**

- Available to rent
- New wheelchairs, including electric scooters!
- New strollers, including double strollers, too!





#### **Elevators**

- There are now TWO elevators from the Concourse Level to the Lower Level:
  - Express Elevator only stops on Concourse and Lower Level
  - East Elevator stops on Concourse, Mezzanine A, Mezzanine B and Lower Level
- Due to the stairs and escalators, Ruthven, Mallory and Fountain Galleries and the Classrooms can only be accessed by wheelchair and stroller users via the East Elevator.



# **CPR Kiosk**

 Located on the Lower Level, across from Beansprouts Café, this is a CPR training kiosk for guests to learn from and practice on.
